

**County Executive's Report**  
**January 13, 2020**

- Executive Woody discussed with the Commission the December 2019 summary of Financial Statement, drawing attention to the property tax collection at 49%, compared to last December at 45%. Further attention was drawn to the difference in revenue and expenditure in each fund. The difference in revenue versus expenditures were discussed, as this difference reflects the need for the Fund Balance Policy and having sufficient fund to operate prior to revenue of property tax being received.
- Director of Accounts and Budgets, Connie Cook distributed a tri-fold Popular Annual Financial Report. The commission reviewed a couple items within the report.
- Executive Woody mentioned to commission a recent conference call with Standard and Poors related to the County's Bond ratings. The County has again received a good rating of AA and the report mentioned strong financial reporting and polices.
- Executive Woody then turned time over to Susan Witt with the U.S. Census. Mrs. Witt discussed the Roane County Census Committee and planning of the April 1 Census date and count.
