- Correspondence #8 is the county owned back tax committee minutes. There was a discussion regarding the Dock at Caney Caney and having a separate back tax sale of these properties. The committee approved a having a separate sale. You will see in correspondence #22 a letter from my office asking Sandy McPherson to proceed with scheduling this sale.
- Correspondence #23 is State appropriation for a new training facility in Oak Ridge benefiting citizens of Oak Ridge and Roane County.
- The School filed with us last month in our packet a request for funding of \$5 million for completion of Oliver Springs High School. We anticipate filing a Debt resolution next month.
- TVA will be holding an Open House on the Kingston Fossil Plant on Thursday, August 15 from 5-7pm at Noah's Event Center.
- The Environmental Review Board will be having a public hearing on August 15 form 6-7 at the Courthouse.
- At the September 5th Environmental Review Board meeting along with TDEC and the Department Health they will release the findings of the soil sampling from the Swan Pond Sports Complex.
